

HV Provider Guidance for ACEs Facilitation

Tips

- ✓ Effective 7/1/18 this tool will be required for all families.
- ✓ Tool is administered once rapport is built with the family and completed within the first 6 months of enrollment.
- ✓ HFA HV's should start with Parent Survey and complete missing pieces after model specific tool is completed.
- ✓ Review Crittenton toolkit for more steps on how to implement the survey
- ✓ Explain what score results mean with family, and provide referral to mental health or other social supports if needed.
- ✓ Remember: Home Visiting is a key resource! By the family being linked with home visiting they are already linked with a key resource to help mitigate such experiences!
