# Keep kids eyes healthy.

## Prevention

Ninety percent of sports-related eye injuries may be prevented with protective eyewear. The Save Our Sight Fund distributes free baseball helmets, face guards, and basketball goggles to amateur youth sport teams and protective eyewear to vocational schools throughout Ohio.

## Screening

Up to twenty-five percent of school-age children have an eye or vision condition that, if not corrected, could result in reduced vision. The Save Our Sight Fund provides training, certification, and equipment for vision screenings. Once trained, screeners can screen students from preschool through high school.

## Education

The Save Our Sight Fund supports educational programs that stress the importance of eye safety, eye health, and eye protection.

## Support

Amblyopia occurs when one or both eyes do not develop normal vision during early childhood.

The Ohio Amblyope Registry provides information, case management, support services and free eye patches to children and their families.
