# Medicaid Managed Care Plans Offer Help to Members with Asthma



### Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

Medicaid managed care plans may offer bus passes or pay for rides to and from:

- Doctor's visits
- Drug stores
- Food banks
- Medicaid, WIC, or SSI offices

Check with your plan to find out if medical transportation is available, if you need a doctor's note, and how to set up a ride.

### Medical Care Management

Managed care plans offer extra help to members with diseases like asthma. Care managers will help coordinate between different doctors and teach you how to take care of your child's asthma. A nurse or another person who works for the plan may call you on the phone or meet you in person.

#### Care managers can help you:

- Find the right doctor
- Learn how to take care of asthma at home
- Learn how to use medications
- Find free community services (e.g., resources to quit smoking or vaping)

Different Medicaid managed care plans have different services and benefits. Please call the number on the back of your ID card to find more information about your plan and for possible telehealth options.
