



The Ohio Department of Health School Nurse Bulletin Board

The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) School Nursing program's electronic School Nurse Bulletin Board is a method used to provide timely information to nurses working in schools across the state. This is a one-way means of communication from ODH to nurses. Messages from the ODH School Nurse Bulletin Board are delivered to your email Inbox. In addition, the School Nurse Bulletin Board is considered by ODH to be a primary method to provide information to school nurses and school communities during emergency situations. There are two message boards available:

- Early Childhood Health: Any professional working with families or young children is encouraged to register.
- School Nurse: All Ohio licensed nurses working in an Ohio school(s) or Ohio licensed nurses who supervise nurses working in an Ohio school(s) are encouraged to register to receive the school nurse messages.
