

Immunization Quality Improvement Program (IQIP)

What is IQIP?

IQIP is an immunization quality improvement program (QI) that uses evidence-based methods to assist and support health care providers by identifying opportunities to:

- **Improve vaccine uptake and coverage.**
- **Reduce missed opportunities to vaccinate.**
- **Keep staff up to date with current recommendations.**

Participating providers will focus on implementing simple and sustainable activities into their immunization workflow, resulting in long term improvements.

What is the Cost of the Program?

It is a **free** program for pediatric & adolescent immunization providers in Ohio!

What are the Program Benefits?

Providers who participated **saw increases in vaccine coverage rates** for their pediatric and adolescent patients.

- **Providers on average saw a 3% increase for DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) and MMR (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) vaccines.**
- **Providers on average saw a 7% increase for HPV (Human Papillomavirus).**

An IQIP Consultant Will Work With You and Your Staff Throughout a 12-Month Cycle To:

INITIAL SITE VISIT



Review immunization coverage assessments and set goals.
Design QI plan to implement.

2-MONTH CHECK IN



Progress check and technical assistance.

6-MONTH CHECK IN



Progress check and technical assistance.

12-MONTH FOLLOW UP



Assess QI progress and technical assistance.
Evaluate change in coverage assessments.
