



## Ohio Department of Health School Nursing Program Train-the-Trainer for Nurses in Ohio Schools: Medication Administration

The revised course, *Train-the-Trainer for Nurses in Ohio Schools: Medication Administration*, is now available online.

This medication administration train-the-trainer course is designed for licensed health professionals and builds upon their nursing experience and knowledge. Following successful completion of the training, the licensed health professional will have access to the course materials for training designated school employees in the administration of medication to students. This course is not meant for school employees without health professional licensure—unlicensed school employees should seek training on medication administration in accordance with Ohio law.

The revised course content includes information on daily, as needed, and stock emergency medications. Updated sections include video instructions and training slide resources for the school nurse. Updated skill checklists and post-tests for the medication administration modules are also included.
