

Teen Driving Safety: GDL Module for Students and Parents:

Automobile crashes continue to be one of the biggest risks of injury among teen drivers. From 2016-2018, there were 132,163 traffic crashes in Ohio involving at least one teen driver, which is almost 15% of all crashes (*Ohio State Patrol*). The first years of driving are the most dangerous for teens, which is the reason why understanding and enforcing Ohio's Graduated Driver Licensing (GDL) laws are so important. The GDL Module created by Impact Teen Driver is a quick and easy way to educate teens and their parents on GDL Law and how it reduces risk of injury and saves lives.

We strongly encourage you to take this module and post-survey with your parent or guardian to help reiterate the importance of safe driving practices. It includes interactive activities, knowledge checkpoints, and a real-life story from a teen who was in a preventable distracted driving crash.
