## State Loan Repayment Programs

<b>Program Description</b>	The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) State Loan Repayment Programs offer loan repayment to eligible health professionals working in federally designated health professional shortage areas (HPSAs) or state designated health resource shortage areas. Loan repayment is offered through the Ohio Physician Loan Repayment Program, Ohio Dentist Loan Repayment Program, Ohio Dental Hygienist Loan Repayment Program and the Ohio Health Professional Loan Repayment Program.
<b>Eligible Disciplines</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Physicians (family medicine, internal medicine, obstetrics/gynecology, pediatrics, adolescent medicine, geriatrics, and psychiatry [general, child/adolescent, geriatric]).</li> <li>• Dentists (general and pediatric dentists).</li> <li>• Registered dental hygienists.</li> <li>• Advanced nurse practitioners.</li> <li>• Physician assistants.</li> <li>• Pharmacists.</li> </ul>
<b>Site Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Accept Medicaid.</li> <li>• Accept Assignment for Medicare (physicians only).</li> <li>• Accommodate all patients regardless of their ability to pay.</li> </ul>
<b>Service Commitment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum two-year service commitment.</li> <li>• Optional third and fourth year service commitments (single year commitments).</li> <li>• Full-time (40 hours per week) or part-time (20-39 hours per week) options.</li> </ul>
<b>Financial Benefits</b>	<p>Loan repayment assistance for qualified education debt.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Up to \$50,000 (full-time) or \$25,000 (part-time) for initial two-year contract.</li> <li>• Up to \$35,000 (full-time) or \$17,500 (part-time) for additional third and fourth year commitment.</li> </ul>
<b>Tax Liability</b>	Not taxable.
<b>Application Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• U.S. citizen (U.S. born or naturalized), U.S. national, or lawful permanent resident.</li> <li>• Currently working or accepted to work at an eligible site that is located in a federally designated HPSA or a state designated health resource shortage area.</li> </ul>
