According to the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, a blood lead test result of **3.5 µg/dL** or more means that your child has been exposed to lead. Some children who have high blood lead levels have problems with learning, behavior, attention and hearing. There are some things you can do to help bring down your child’s lead level:
