

[Ohio Revised Code \(“R.C.”\) 9.78](#) requires the Ohio Department of Health (“Department”) to “make available to the public on [its] internet web site a list of all criminal offenses of which conviction of that offense shall disqualify an individual from obtaining a license issued or conferred by the [Department].”

## List of Disqualifying Offenses

The list below identifies all criminal offenses of which conviction of that offense will disqualify an individual from obtaining a license. The Department is prohibited by law from issuing a license to any individual convicted of one of the criminal offenses listed in the table below, regardless of the facts and circumstances surrounding the conviction and any subsequent good behavior.
